Dear sisters and brothers

**Information** from the Diocese of North Queensland regarding floods in Townsville

I have recently been in contact with the Venerable Christopher Wright, Administrator of the Diocese of North Queensland, who has sent me the following information concerning the flood situation in Townsville:

The Tropical City of Townsville has suffered a catastrophe after more than 1000mm of rain came down on the city in a short period causing flooding and the evacuations of homes in many of the low lying suburbs. Although Church property only suffered minimal damage the inundation of homes and businesses will have a lasting effect. The Anglican Diocese of North Queensland through its Parishes is co-operating with the other Churches in Townsville to ensure that recovery can be achieved and that no-one wants for food or emergency supplies and that the gaps that often occur when these situations arise are closed. Any assistance you could provide would be greatly appreciated.

The Archbishop's Emergency Relief Appeal, which is currently taking donations for drought relief, will also receive donations for flood relief in North Queensland.
