Lord we pray for the Australian people:

- Peaceful, respectful race relations among various ethnic groups, and that while deep scars of past hurts need to be healed in the hearts of many, respect and love for their fellow Australians will encourage peaceful and constructive dialogue.
- Successful ways of combating the appalling rates of domestic violence that so badly affect the lives of the vulnerable. Lord, show those who would inflict violence the way of love and respect.
- Closing the Gap: That known ways of improving the lives of indigenous people, their health, housing, education and employment be funded and enabled by those who can make a difference in the actual lives of these people. We pray for those taking part in NAIDOC week in June, and for fruitful dialogue.
- Youth justice: That the proposed Inquiry into the Department of Families, and the care

 better ways of supporting both children in Foster Care, and the families who provide
 the care. That ways of providing for children in 'out of home care' may be found that
 will give them better pathways into mainstream living.
- For continuing support for those suffering from the effects of natural disasters, and especially for those who went through the huge floods in the NSW Central Coast, and have lost businesses, homes crops and cattle, and now face cleaning up.
