1. Newton College PNG volunteer staffing needs

Bishop Jeffrey Driver, Principal at Newton College in Popondetta PNG, is asking for some help from one of two volunteers who might be prepared to spend 2-3 weeks in the college. He is looking for someone with accounts experience to help improve the financial systems. The volunteer would need to be familiar with a programme such as MYOB or Quickbooks.

The other need is in the library, where the college needs upgrade the digital cataloguing and provide access to digital journals.

Accommodation would be in a quite comfortable and recently renovated cottage. Bishop Jeffrey is hoping for the volunteers to be available between February and April next year.

Newton College is 9 kilometres out of Popondetta, on the Northern side of PNG. The college community is about 90 people, of these around 20 are full time ordinands.


