



COVID UPDATE 11th March 2022

The Queensland Government has announced that the COVID restrictions in SEQ have been changed with effect from 11th March 2022.

- **All restrictions for attendance at Holy Spirit Church, Kenmore and Good Shepherd Church Brookfield and associated Halls have been lifted except in the case of Weddings** (where no occupancy limits apply UNLESS any persons who are unvaccinated are attending, in which case the limit is twenty (20) people)
- **Face masks are no longer required to be worn** - including for any form of church activities, although individuals should consider doing so in the following circumstances:
 - Persons having a high temperature or any symptoms consistent with COVID-19;
 - Persons awaiting the results of a COVID-19 PCR test; or
 - Unvaccinated ACSQ workers required to wear a face mask as a control measure under the ACSQ COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement Policy.

Church Policy will be that people can feel free at their own option to wear a face mask for their own personal safety.
- **Contact Information is no longer required to be provided**, by means of the Check In Qld App for any church activities including worship.
- **Density restrictions for church activities have been lifted with the exception of weddings as described above.**
- There are no restrictions on singing and food/beverage service, However physical distancing and other hygiene measures should be observed to the extent possible, such as the use of hand sanitiser and avoiding handshakes.
